

AFRICA MISSION REPORT



GREETINGS,

Kingdom and Glory Ministries, greets you all in the Name of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. A brief summary of the mission works we have accomplished so far in Africa, are displayed below through this report. We are grateful to all those who have helped in making this mission a success.

Pr. Santhosh David, founder and director of *Kingdom and Glory Ministries* (India & Africa) started his ministry in 1987, at the age of 17. It was after his baptism in the Holy Spirit that God gave him a vision and a deep burden for **Africa**. By Gods Grace, the door finally opened 28 years later.



❖ **2015:**

Reached Uganda by a divine intervention and God opened some ways to start teaching pastors the truth of the Kingdom and the Glory of God. Thereafter, we had frequently visited and conducted pastor's seminars and short-term Bible training programs for two years.

❖ **2017:**

- **January**, we reached a refugee settlement in a remote village called: **Rwamwanja, Uganda** located around 300 km away from the **Entebbe airport** to conduct a pastors' seminar.
- The things my team and I have seen in this place are so heart breaking, including the testimonies told by the refugees about the violence they had suffered in their countries. Still living under the fear and anxiety of rape and war, these people are left out to sleep in **polythene partition** and **mud huts**. Basic needs like nutritious food, clothes, education and modern medical treatment facilities are still unreachable to them. They are left out in unspeakable and horrible circumstances, trying to just make it through another day. From children to adults hundreds wait in queue for periods of time just to fetch water as it is a daily scene over here. Thousands of orphans including physically and mentally disabled children, as well as those abused mentally remain here. This is not an unusual incident because there is a large amount of human trafficking and sexual exploitation in the continent.

We highly appreciate the support and the great work effort given by United Nations High Commissioner for Refugees (*UNHCR*) and the government of UGANDA. Much help is still needed in many areas for the uplifting of

this people. It came to our attention that there are more than 10 refugee settlements of 1.8 million people plus according to UNHCR, 2018.

The host community's situation isn't any far better than the refugees. The spiritual state of the communities in many villages are very poor, people are without the right teaching of the Kingdom of God.

- God has given us a burden to start a ministry among refugees as well as the host community.
- **March**, we **registered** our ministry as an **NGO** to work among the people of Africa.

- **April**, we purchased a one-acre land and got the opportunity to start the **construction of 8000sq.ft building** for the **School of Mission** also referred to as the 1-year Bible school.



- **Kingdom and Glory Worship Center**
(KGWC)

April, a church was formed at **Katalyeba**, in the district of **Kamwenge, Uganda**.

➤ **Glorious Kids Castle:**

It's a school for the physical and mentally challenged kids, whom are very common among the refugees and nationals.



❖ **2018:**

➤ **April**, the building construction was finished.



➤ **International Academy of Five Fold Ministries (IAFFM):**

May, we started a 1 year school to teach the eternal truths in the Word of God and to send our students to the nations, for the Bible says: "*the harvest is ready...*". Programs were held in time frames of one week to two weeks, one month and 3 months.

➤ **Kingdom and Glory Nursery School:**

September, we started a free **Boarding School** using a curriculum to produce a group of children that would have Kingdom standards. In the **third term 285 children enrolled**, with John Masirika as our Coordinator, Akampurira Justus as our Head teacher and 7 other teachers.



➤ **Crusade Unit:**



- Pr. Finny Stephen (Kerala,India), Pr. Anish Mano Stephen(Hope in Jesus Ministries, India) as well as our Evangelist team joined us in this mission to share the Gospel in Africa.

- They set up mobile crusade units in Uganda. (Not only was our Evangelist team trained in the true Word of God but also in sound, lights, musical equipment and make shift platforms). Pr. Finny and Pr. Anish also preached the Gospel to the East African nations.

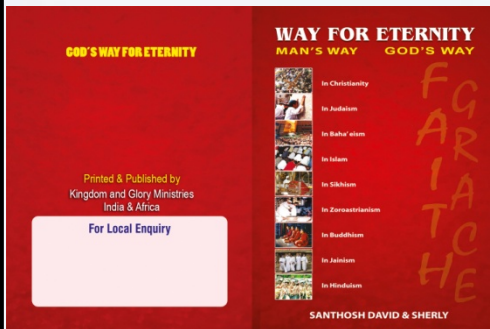

❖ 2019:

➤ Staff Quarters:

February, we were able to build staff quarters in the Bible School compound for accommodating our missionaries from different parts of the world.



➤ Church Planting:

7 Churches have been planted by the ministry so far. Alongside our established churches, the **Home Church Department** is conducting over **27 home churches** while **20 of them are refugees** and the rest are a variety of **different nationals** from **different places**.

The **Church and Home Church department** is led by a group of pastors and evangelists including: Allain Cosmos, John Masirika, Delphine Nzabanita, Sherly Santhosh, Paul Joy, Sheba Santhosh, Ephraim Santhosh, and Vaisakh who contribute daily to the edification of the body of Christ.

➤ Started our **Leaders and English training program** which is held at the main church in **Katalyeba** along with our **Kids and Youth Church program** in all churches.

➤ Children's Village:

This year we initiated our **"Children's Village"**, a program for under privileged children, orphans and boarders to study as well as board. Currently we have **56 children(22 girls and 34 boys)**.



NEEDS IN AFRICA MISSION

➤ **School of mission:**

1. To train up 500 people in every year to go to different parts of Africa with the Gospel. There are many people from refugees and host community who are ready to study the Word of God. In these refugee settlements there are refugees from different parts of Africa.
2. We are seeking for sponsors to meet the expenses of our Bible school students, for land (**5 acre**), building, mattress, cot and other necessary things.
3. **Sponsor**
 - (a) Bible school student - **30USD/month**
 - (b) A missionary - **50USD/month**
 - (c) A missionary Family - **100 USD/month**

➤ **Children's Village:** A special project in view to rehabilitate **1000 homeless children** and to provide them free education. The advance amount has been paid already for **18 acre** land but the remaining **60,000 USD** needs to be paid off before the middle of April, 2020.

➤ **Glorious Kids Castle (Special School):** Construction for the building of our Special School

➤ **Primary School:** 350 children in the Primary School need uniforms this academic year.

➤ **Crusade Unit:** Our Village Crusade Unit needs a vehicle.

➤ **BIBLE & Gospel Tracts:** Bible needs in regional languages such as: Kinyabisha, Kinyarwanda, Swahili, French, Runyankore, Rutooro and Luganda.

➤ **Local church building:** Villages need construction of buildings for the gathering of Churches.
